### **IMPORTANT NOTES FORM KODIAKS ATHLETICS**

- On Friday all 15 passenger buses or vans are to park in the north parking lot as shown on the enclosed map. Larger vehicles will need to park in the Enmax Centre parking lot. There will be free parking to the west of the gymnasium on Saturday and paid parking to the North of the gym on Friday and Saturday.
- There is a coaches' room (Molson Room PE 2404) set up for your convenience in the class room across from the dance room, upper physical education building. Coaches only!  
**Coaches' room will be opened 2:00 pm Friday**
- We will be following the schedule time-line closely to ensure the tournament remains on time. Your players may be given a minimum of 10 minutes on the court to warm up (each team will have 3 minutes for ball warm-up, 3 minutes to hit separately and one minute to serve.... time permitting). There will be more time allocated for ball warm-up and hitting if time allows.
- **PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW YOUR PLAYERS TO PLAY VOLLEYBALL OR RUN IN THE LETHBRIDGE COLLEGE HALLWAYS, STAIRS AND CORRIDORS.**
- All running and stretching should be done on the court or outside.
- We are not responsible for thefts that occur during the tournament. Athletes are encouraged to bring their own locks and use the day lockers in the change rooms or take their belongings to the team benches during competition.
- A tournament result board will be posted next to the equipment room on the main floor of the P.E. Building.
- First and second place along with consolation awards will be presented after the final match along with MVP awards.
- The tournament is officiated by the Lethbridge College men's and women's volleyball teams. There is a mixed level of officiating experience on our teams, but all know the game very well and will do the best job they possibly can. As previously stated, please work with the officials to make this a great tournament. Feel free to give them feedback at the conclusion of the match (in as positive a fashion as possible), but please respect their decisions during the game.
- This event is an important fundraiser for our team and we really appreciate your support. We'll do everything we can to ensure that your athletes have a good experience.
- The scorekeepers will be voting on the men's and women's MVP. The awards will be handed out after the final game on Saturday.

# TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Teams must supply their own warm-up balls
2. Teams must supply one linesperson for each match
3. 12 unlimited substitution rule
4. Round robin matches consist of 2 games, rally point to 25; **there is no cap.**
5. There will NOT BE ANY time limits on the game
6. If a team is late for their game they will default the first set (0-25), after 15 minutes from start time. If they are not ready 30 minutes after their start time, they will default (0- 25) their second set.
7. Round robin matches that are split 1 set each will still have a winner of the match awarded. The team that scores more points combined in the two sets will be deemed the winner. This will be considered a match win and not a tie. Matches won are the first tie breaker. If point totals are exactly the same, a tie will be recorded.
8. The following tie breaking procedures will be used if two or more teams are tied at the end of the round robin:
  - a. The team having the best ratio of won/lost sets, considering matches between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
  - b. The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
  - c. The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering all matches of the round robin, will be ranked higher.
  - d. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
  - e. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played during the round robin, will be ranked higher.
  - f. Coin toss
9. Playoff matches consist of a best 2 out of 3 games. Games one and two will be rally point to 25 with no cap; game three will be rally point to 15, with no cap.
