

COLJHAA JV & SV Boys Post-Season Volleyball Tournament

October 26-27, 2018

RI Baker Middle School- 1101 - 22nd Ave, Coaldale

Greetings, coaches! We're looking forward to seeing you on the weekend for the JV & SV Boys Post-season tournament! Please read over the following information before the weekend.

Tournament Format: Teams have been divided into two pools, based on their league game standings. The make ups of the pools are according to the COLJHAA Handbook. Each team will play all of the teams in their pool. The top two teams from each pool will advance to the semi-finals.

All **round-robin matches will be 2 games**. Both games will be played to 25 points with a difference of two points, no cap. The number of games won determines the ranking after the round robin. All **play-off matches will be best-of-three games**, first two games to 25 points with a difference of two points, no cap and the third game to 15 points with a difference of two points, no cap. See tie-breaker procedures below.

TIE-BREAKER Procedure:

The intent of the tie-breaking procedure is to establish order for a play-off, not to eliminate a team from advancing to the play-offs. Order is established by games won during the round robin. The following criteria will be applied, in order:

- a) The team having the best ratio of won/lost *matches, considering contests between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- b) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering contests played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- c) The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all contests of the round, will be ranked higher;
- d) The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- e) The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher;

Once order is established, if one team is to be eliminated, a single game (rally point scoring to 25 points with a 2-point difference) will be played to determine advancement.

Eligibility: Teams must be comprised only of players that are on original rosters. Floater rules, as outlined in the handbook, will need to be followed.

Awards: COLJHAA Banner for the first place team, plaque for finalists, along with individual medallions for both first and second place.

Each team will also be given a Player of the Game award each game (the coaches nominate their own team's player of the game), sponsored by Booster Juice and Subway.

Cost: The entry fee is **\$175 per team**. Please make cheques payable to RI Baker Middle School. Cheques can be given to Adrienne Vanhell or Megan Leusink.

Rules: League rules will be followed. Please see handbook.

Officials: We will be using local officials. All officials will have experience at refereeing.

Local rules: **coaches are responsible for the supervision of their players and are asked to relay the following rules to them.**

1. Students are not to leave any valuables in the change rooms, as change rooms will be shared. RIBMS will not be held responsible for lost items.
2. Coaches are to ensure that the change room is left in the same condition as they were when they arrived.
3. **Please bring your own warm up balls.**
4. Teams are to warm up in the gym only, there are to be no balls in the change rooms or the hallways.

Concession: There will be a school run concession, including Booster Juice open to the players and spectators at RIBMS.

There will be a coach's corner (only for coaches and officials) in the foods room across from the gym.
